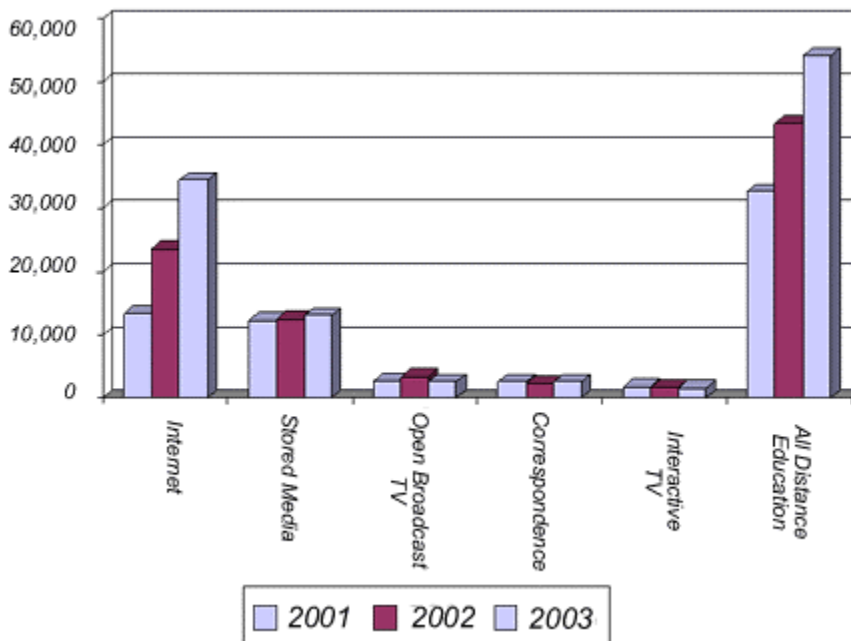




Distance Education Enrollments at Illinois Colleges and Universities Summer Term 2003/Academic Year 2002-2003

A survey completed by the **Illinois Virtual Campus** shows that **online** enrollments at Illinois colleges and universities continue to increase dramatically. Illinois colleges and universities reported offering **2,625** online class sections that generated **34,399** student course enrollments during the Summer 2003 term. This is an increase of **10,748** course enrollments (**45%**) from the **23,651** online enrollments reported for the Summer 2002 term. Illinois institutions reported offering **4,382** course sections in all distance education delivery modes that generated **54,131** course enrollments. This is an increase of **1,103** course sections and an increase of **10,665** course enrollments from the **3,279** course sections that generated **43,466** course enrollments in the Summer 2002 term. While online course enrollments increased by **10,748**, the enrollments in the other delivery modes except online showed little change from the previous summer term.

Enrollments in All Distance Education Delivery Modes

Online enrollments accounted for **64%** of all distance education enrollments in the Summer 2003 term compared to **54%** of the total enrollments in the Summer 2002 term. Enrollments in interactive TV/video courses decreased **10%**, and enrollments in open broadcast TV courses decreased by **24%** from Summer 2002 term. Enrollments in stored media courses increased by **5%** and enrollments in correspondence courses increased by **11%** from the previous year. The table below shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Summer 2002 to Summer 2003.

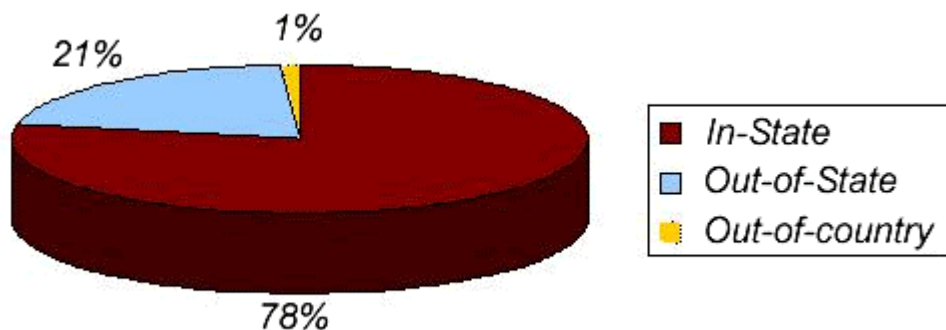
Online Enrollments by Sector

During Summer 2003 term, community colleges reported offering **1,489** online course sections that generated **16,914** enrollments. Public universities reported offering **363** online course sections that generated **7,793** enrollments and independent colleges and universities reported offering **773** online courses that generated **9,692** enrollments. The Illinois institutions reporting the largest online course enrollments during the Summer 2003 term in each sector of higher education in Illinois were: **Parkland College** from the community college system with **1,936**, **University of Illinois at Chicago** from the public universities with **3,833**, and **DeVry University** from the independent colleges and universities with **5,576**.

Online Enrollments by Residency

The vast majority of all online course enrollments reported by Illinois colleges and universities were students residing in the state. **In-state** students accounted for **78%** of the online course enrollments, **out-of-state** residents accounted for **21%**, and **out-of-country** residents accounted for **1%**. The residency of students enrolled in online courses varied by sector, with community colleges having the highest percentage of Illinois residents (**96%**), followed by the public universities (**82%**), and the independent colleges and universities (**43%**). The graph below shows the distributions of online enrollments at all Illinois colleges and universities by residency.

Annual Academic Year Enrollments

Illinois colleges and universities reported a total of **125,074** online course enrollments and **205,625** course enrollments in all distance education modes during **academic year 2002-2003** (Fall 2002, Spring 2003, and Summer 2003). This is an increase of **43,620 (54%)** online course enrollments and an increase of **39,927 (24%)** course enrollments in all distance education delivery modes from the previous academic year (2001-2002). The table below shows the changes in distance education enrollments from academic year 2001-2002 to academic year 2002-2003.
